Welcome to CBC's August Newsletter.

Schools are finished for the holidays and many families will be taking a well-earned rest. However, this can be a stressful time for parents having to fit in work and child-care. Also, it can be a very expensive when children are not receiving the benefit of school meals and families are having to use more electricity at home. With many off on holiday, there will be some who cannot afford such luxuries or even a day out with the children. The Rise Trust (which CBC has supported) works with families in Calne who have particular needs, offering advice, training and practical help. Calne Food Bank has seen an increase in the number of people asking for food/everyday items and is always in need of supplies.
